

# ICHEP2022 Second Bulletin, 31/03/2022

The INFN Divisions and Universities of Bologna and Ferrara are proud to announce that the 41<sup>st</sup> International Conference on High Energy Physics (ICHEP 2022) will be hosted in Bologna from July 6<sup>th</sup> to July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022. It is the first time in its long and prestigious history that the most important conference of the HEP community will be held in Italy.

#### Latest news

- Considering the recent measurements taken by the CERN council and after consulting with IUPAP, the ICHEP 2022 Local Organising Committee has decided to suspend the participation of the institutions located in the Russian Federation and in the Republic of Belarus in all scientific committees and activities related to the ICHEP 2022 conference. As a consequence, people employed by these institutions should participate to the conference activities personally (without their affiliation) or with a IUPAP affiliation (subject to approval by IUPAP).
- The deadline for abstract submission has been extended to April 15, 2022.
- The list of conveners for the 17 parallel session is now complete and available from the conference web site

## Support for participants

Different kinds of financial support are available, especially thanks to the sponsorship of many institutions and laboratories. Fee reduction or waiver can be granted to conference attendees coming from disadvantaged countries. In exceptional cases support for accommodation and/or travel expenses can also be granted. Attendees unable to travel, because of the pandemic condition in their countries, are eligible for a reduction of the on-line participation fee. Support is foreseen for attendees with children in tow and for attendees with special needs. Family grants up to a maximum of 300 Euros are available. All the requests for support should be motivated

and submitted for approval to the Local Organizing Committee by using the <u>Financial Support</u> <u>Application</u>. The deadline for submission of the application is **April 30, 2022.** The response from the Local Organizing Committee will be communicated before **May 31, 2022**.

<u>Special support for Ukrainian participants</u>: considering the extremely difficult situation in their country, all Ukrainian participants are eligible for fee waiver. A dedicated budget has also been reserved for extra support to cover the remaining participation costs. All the requests should be submitted using the <u>Financial Support Application</u> as explained above.

On-site childcare will be organised and, up to a certain capacity, we will be able to provide it free of charge. Childcare will be organized in a dedicated space in the same building of the conference venue and will be provided by professional child carers. In order to organise this service, we need to be informed in advance, so please make sure to indicate this on the registration form. The venue will also provide a quiet place for breast feeding, although this will be welcome anywhere, equipped with armchair, changing table and bottle warmer. Some of the social events, including the conference dinner, will provide a special menu, at a reduced price, for children.

The venue and social events will be fully accessible to delegates with reduced mobility.

## Lunches during the conference

The lunches during the conference are not included in the registration fees and can be purchased at the cost of 20 EUR each or 100 EUR for the full package of 6 lunches. We strongly recommend to exploit this opportunity as there are few available alternatives in the vicinity of the conference site. The lunches can be booked starting from May 1 using your registration account, instructions will be sent by email to all registered participants in due time.
